Ear Protection Safety Awareness



Excessive noise within your workplace can be the cause of irreversible hearing damage to those who work in the hazardous areas. Hearing can be permanently damaged from prolonged exposure to high levels of noise. The NEW Noise at Work Regulations came into force April 2006 have almost halved the noise level that employees can be exposed to.

There are many sources of loud noise. Common ones are powered hammering, chainsaw work, grinding, sheet metal working and wood machinery. Poor maintenance can also be a cause, for example holes in compressed air lines, escaping steam, cracked silencers or ill fitting enclosures.

This 1 hour in-house safety briefing will make staff aware of the dangers of noise exposure, and how and why ear protection should be used.
