

Abrasive Wheels (Novice)

Safety in the use of Abrasive Wheels is now covered legally by the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations. There is a requirement in the law that the mounting of Abrasive Wheels should be restricted to properly trained and designated people. This course is designed to give NOVICE delegates the required training.



Aim of the course

This aim of this ourse is to train delegates in the safe working procedures of Abrasive Wheels. The course includes practical "hands-on" exercises using your site specific equipment, and delegates will be tested by our tutor throughout.

Who should attend?

All NOVICE staff who are required to mount and use Abrasive Wheels as part of their job, who have no prior knowledge or experience.
