

Vehicle Banksman - LGV's, Vans, Artics, FLT's

Most accidents occur as a result of poor observation and an inability of the driver to judge the length of the vehicle and pivotal point of the rear axles. Reversing requires the application of basic mechanical principles and all round observation on the drivers part.
