

## **Sharps Awareness**

This half day course is aimed at all staff who may come into contact with discarded needles - such as those staff that are involved with checking premises, grounds/parks and gardens, recreation areas, rented properties, derelict buildings etc. who may come into contact with discarded needles, body fluids and related waste who must be made aware of the risks of infection, and how to avoid becoming infected.

The course covers a three hour tuition period and includes practical exercises, video on the topics, group discussion and tutor lead tutorial.
